After reading the "Amended ACNA bylaw 5.2" email from Keith again, I have another item I would like clarification on.

The email states "The purpose of the amendment to Article V.5.2 is to help the club to grow and expand under new leadership. It also gives the membership opportunities to become involved in the organization in a leadership capacity, allowing them to bring new skills and fresh ideas to develop the organization."

And then it states Dean Ismail and Giovanni Tomasi were selected to fill BoD positions. If the information sent out by the club is correct, Dean and Gio finished 4th and 5th, respectively, in the last election. Dean had also just completed a full term on the BoD. So, if the idea is to truly "grow and expand under new leadership" and allow for "new skills and fresh ideas" then why was John Horner, who finished 3rd in the election not selected? To my knowledge he has not served on the BoD previously and has strong ties to Audi USA which to me more than satisfies the "new leadership" and "new skills and fresh ideas" criteria. Given he also finished ahead of Dean and Gio indicates that the membership selected him ahead of the other two gentlemen.

What is the reason the Exec Committee chose to ignore the members wishes indicated by the election results and the committee's own explanation of the amendment in the selection process?
